

THOMASVILLE EXCHANGE CLUB DEMOLITION DERBY RULES

STOCK

This class was created to have fun and fun for the fans to watch (Total Carnage). If you come with a vehicle that is built any more than what is listed below you will not run.

GENERAL

**ANY 1980's AND NEWER 2 WHEEL DRIVE PASSENGER CAR/MINI-VAN/MINI-TRUCK/MID-SIZE SUV –
NO EL CAMINO's**

1. ALL DRIVERS AND MECHANICS MUST SIGN A HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT AT TIME OF ENTRY.
2. THE DRIVER MUST BE 18 YEARS OLD.
3. ALCOHOL IN PITS MEANS DISQUALIFICATION.
4. ABSOLUTELY NO CHILDREN IN THE PIT AREA.
5. DRIVERS MUST REMAIN IN THEIR SEATBELTS AND HELMET AT ALL TIMES DURING THE COMPETITION.
6. DRIVER IS REQUIRED TO WEAR A NECK BRACE, HELMET, AND EYE PROTECTION.
7. NO INTENTIONAL HITTING IN DRIVER'S DOOR.
8. ALL CARS MUST MAKE CONTACT WITH ANOTHER ACTIVE CAR WITHIN 60 SECONDS. STALLED OR NON-MOVING CARS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
9. NO INTENTIONAL HEAD ON COLLISIONS.
10. NO INTENTIONAL HITTING A NON-FLAGGED CAR.
11. JUDGES ARE NOT AFFILIATED WITH THE EXCHANGE CLUB AND THEIR DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.
12. NUMBERS ON BOTH DOORS 12" TALL, OR DUAL NUMBER PLATE ON TOP OF CAR.
13. ALL CARS MUST HAVE BRAKES.
14. OFFICIALS DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

BUILD RULES

1. All vehicles must be stripped of all plastic, glass, headlights, taillights, and anything else that could fall off onto the track during the show.
2. All vehicles must remain stock, ABSOLUTELY NO WELDING ANYWHERE UNLESS STATED

3. Bumpers must remain stock, do not alter bumper in any way. Factory bumper shocks must remain in factory location. You may remove rear bumpers and shocks. There is no welding to be done on bumpers.
4. Batteries may be left in stock location, and spray foam may be added around battery. You may also move battery to passenger floor or seat. Please make sure battery is not moving.
5. If factory gas tank is in front of axle, you may leave it there. If it is behind the axle, you must move it to the rear seat area. Factory tanks may be moved inside but completely secure. After market tanks may be used.
6. All doors may be wired or chained in 6 places maximum per seam.
7. Trunks, hoods, and tailgates may be wired or chained in 6 places total. Sheet metal to sheet metal only. Nothing to frame or bumpers. If you remove trunk or tailgate, you lose that wire or chain.
8. Rear seat bar may be added and can be welded to post. If you must add something to get it away from the seat, please call. This is only to stop sides from coming in, not to help any other part of the vehicle.
9. Driver's door may only have a plate welded to the outside or inside. This is for drivers' safety.
10. DOT tires only. Stock wheels only. All wheel weights must be removed. Only tubes and air are permitted inside of tires.

These rules are cut and dry, you should not have to call and ask many questions in this class. If it does not say you can do it then that means YOU CANNOT do it. Quick and easy build.
