Entry Dates for Home Craft Exhibits:

Friday, October 8th, 2021 (2:00PM - 6:00PM)

Saturday, October 9th, 2021 (11:00AM - 3:00PM)

Entry Dates for Baked Goods ONLY:

Monday, October 11th, 2021 (7:30AM-10:00 AM)

Actual Fair Dates:

Tuesday, October 12th, 2021 - Saturday, October 16th, 2021

Entry and Prize Money Pick Up Date:

Sunday, October 17th, 2021 (1:00PM - 3:00PM)

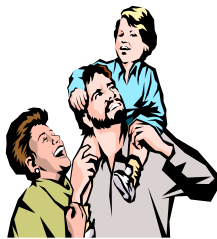

Home Craft Exhibits General Rules

DIVISIONS



(One division will not compete against the other)

1. Youth (Ages 5 through 17)
2. Adult-Non Professional
3. Adult-Professional
4. Parent/Child (All ages)
5. Handicap (All ages)

1. Exhibits will be received between **2:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M., Friday, October 8th, 2021**, and between **11:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M., Saturday, October 9th, 2021**, at the Arts and Crafts Building of the fair grounds. After these hours they may be received only by special permission from the chairman of the Fair Home Crafts Committee. **Baked Goods are the only exception to these dates and times (see “Baking Special Rules”) Monday, October 11th, 2021, between 7:30A.M. and 10:00 A.M..**

2. All entries and awards in this department shall be subject to the following rules and instructions and the general fair rules. The decision of the judges in all cases will be considered final.

3. All judging will be on the Danish system and awards, prizes, or ribbons, based on their own merits. Due to this judging system, categories and/or classifications will not be necessary.

4. Professionals are those who make and sell to order or instruct.

5. All articles entered must be the handiwork of the exhibitor. Anything entered in the youth division should be the work of the child and will be judged with the consideration of the age of the youth.

6. The Handicap Division is designed for those individuals who feel they have some type of handicap that requires special consideration.

7. The Parent/Child Division is designed for entries that have been prepared by a parent and child together. All ages are welcomed.

8. All articles must have been made within the last 2 years, and never entered in this fair previously.

9. **Exhibits must be removed 1:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M., Sunday, October 17, 2021.** No premium money will be paid without the presentation claim check.

10. All of the Home Crafts divisions are opened to any child ages 5-17 and judged separately from the adults. Their age will be listed on the entry tag for judging consideration. Please do not enter adult work under a child's name!

11. Ribbons and cash awards will be given for the first three places as indicated in each class.

12. Premiums will be paid from the awards marked in the judge's books and not from the ribbon attached to exhibits, ribbons sometimes become misplaced when articles are being judged or displayed.

13. Exhibitors from surrounding counties may participate.

14. Judging will be based on originality, craftsmanship, and suitability to purpose.

15. While every precaution will be taken for safeguarding exhibits it should be understood that the owner assumes all responsibility for any accident, loss or damage that may occur. Neither the Fair, its officers, or committee members will be responsible for any such accident, loss or damage.

16. Duplicate and similar items will be judged together as a set.

17. Prize monies, ribbons and entries not claimed on pick up date, will be forfeited.

18. Do not confuse “Home Craft” exhibits with “Fine Art” exhibits. They have different rules, judges and entry times.
